- Procedures for student housing evacuation Residents:

**On activation of Fire Alarm**

Everyone is to exit the building if safe and assemble outside where staff will take attendance.

If it unsafe to enter the corridor, residents are instructed to close their room door, place something at the bottom of the door to keep smoke out , call University Police., and then go to the window and call/signal for help.

Staff: Immediately exit the building if safe, take master keys, coat and floor roster (if in hall office take the Hall Roster).

Knock on doors and attempt to clear your floor as you leave **Do not put yourself in danger.**

Report to the fire panel room of the building where specific instructions will be given by the professional staff: may be asked to secure doorways, take attendance at assembly areas, return to your floor to key into rooms. Staff will not be asked to put themselves in danger.

- Policies for fire safety education and training programs for students, facility and staff  
Students: Are given fire safety information during mandatory floor meetings within the first week of classes at the beginning of each academic year. Fire safety training for the students complies with the criteria established in the NYS Campus Fire Safety Training Guidelines as established by the Office of Fire Prevention and Control.

Staff: Are required to participate in a week long training program wherein specific information on their responsibilities and methods for dealing with emergencies is provided. Training in fire safety includes a day long program that contains practical instruction in the use of portable fire extinguishers, negotiating a smoke filled corridor, fire safety awareness, an emergency situation table top exercise and a live fire demonstration.
