Timely Warning
From
University Police



An incident has occurred on or near a University at Buffalo campus that may pose a continuing threat to the university community. This warning is provided so that you may take whatever action is deemed necessary for your safety.

University Police are investigating a strong-arm robbery that occurred on February 3, 2008 at approximately 7:55 p.m. in the Main/Bailey Parking Lot.

The victim was approached from behind and assaulted by a group described as four black males, 5' 10" - 6' 0" tall, in their late teens to early twenties in age, and all wearing dark clothing. There was no weapon displayed in this incident and the suspects fled eastbound on Main Street. The suspects took the victim's bag of food that was just purchased at a fast food restaurant.

To protect yourself, remember to stay to your surroundings and always travel with other people. When possible, use the Anti-Rape Task Force escort program or other UB transportation services. Call 829-2584 for escort program information or go to their Web site at healtheducation.buffalo.edu.

Members of the community are urged to be vigilant at all times. Report any unusual circumstances or suspicious persons and activities to the University Police as soon as possible.
