Timely Warning
From
University Police



An incident has occurred on or near a University at Buffalo campus that may pose a continuing threat to the university community. This warning is provided so that you may take whatever action is deemed necessary for your safety.

The Buffalo Police received a report of an armed robbery which occurred at the intersection of Main street and Englewood avenue at 2:05 AM on Monday April 27, 2009. Three Male suspects approached the victim and displayed a revolver. The suspects took the victim's iPhone and laptop. The suspects were last seen running through the Townsend parking lot and then behind Saint Joseph's Church.

- University Police received a call on 4-29-09 at 1:38 AM of 2-students who were robbed at gun point by Hayes Hall. University Police immediately broadcast this information to Erie County Police Agencies and BPD apprehended the suspects. Suspects were positively Identified and turned over to the University Police. The University Police Investigators will work with Buffalo Police to see if these two crimes are related.

While this recent threat has been resolved with arrests, please remember to stay alert to your surroundings and always travel with other people. When possible, use the Anti-Rape Task Force escort program (348-7258) or other UB transportation services.

Members of the community are urged to be vigilant at all times. Report any unusual circumstances or suspicious persons and activities to the University Police as soon as possible.
