Timely Warning

University Police



An incident has occurred near a University at Buffalo North Campus that may pose a continuing threat to the university community. This warning is provided so that you may take whatever action is deemed necessary for your safety.

Amherst police are looking for a man that may have been involved in two incidents of performing a lewd act on the Tonawanda and Ellicott Creek Bike Paths.

On May 7th, at approximately 1:15 PM, a white male in his late teens or early twenties weighing about 170 pounds was seen on the Tonawanda Creek portion of the bike path engaging in a lewd act.

On June 1st, a similar incident occurred on the Ellicott Creek portion of the bike path, about a mile from North Forest Road with the suspect description matching that of the person from the earlier incident. This person was wearing a sweatshirt and sweat pants.
