Timely Warning
From
University Police



An incident has occurred on or near a University at Buffalo campus that may pose a continuing threat to the university community. This warning is provided so that you may take whatever action is deemed necessary for your safety.

University Police received a report on 10-04-09 at 10:10PM of a student who stated he was robbed at gun point on Lee road near Jarvis B Parking Lot. A second student reports also being robbed shortly after the first reported incident between Ketter Hall and Putnam Way. Victims reported the suspects were two black males, both wearing dark clothing, one wearing a black scarf on his head armed with a silver handgun. One suspect was reported to be approx. 6 feet tall, the other approx. 5'8" to 5'10" tall. Suspects last seen on foot from Ketter Hall toward Fronczak B Lot.

To protect yourself, remember to stay alert to your surroundings and always travel with other people. When possible, use the Anti-Rape Task Force escort program or other UB transportation services. Call 829-2584 for escort program information from 9 AM to 5 PM Monday through Friday or go to their Web site at healtheducation.buffalo.edu.

Members of the community are urged to be vigilant at all times. Report any unusual circumstances or suspicious persons and activities to the University Police as soon as possible.
